The N.N. Petrov National Medicine Research Center of oncology – is the first specialized oncology clinic in Russian Federation, founded in 1927. It remains one of the largest centers for diagnostics, treatment, scientific research and education in Russia.

Full range of treatment modalities including radiotherapy, stereotactic radiotherapy, advanced surgery involving micro and reconstructive techniques also with endoscopic approach, chemotherapy, including high-dose CT with bone marrow transplantation are available for patients from all over Russia.

The staff of the N.N. Petrov NMRC of oncology is composed of: 209 specialists with the PhD degree, 22 Professors, 3 Corresponding Members of Russian Academy of Sciences, 1 Honored Scientist of the Russian Federation, 5 Honored Doctors of the Russian Federation.

The N.N. Petrov NMRC of oncology is a center of excellence and continuous education, providing study opportunities for physicians seeking perfection in laparoscopic abdominal, thoracic, gynecological, urological, breast and plastic surgery, sentinel node biopsy, reconstructive surgery.

Fundamental and clinical research activities in genetics of cancer, cancerogenesis and ageing, prevention and early detection, researches in immunology and vaccination, development of novel treatment approaches are an essential part of work.

The N.N. Petrov NMRC organizes more than 50 scientific and practical education events such as workshops, masterclasses, webinars and big conferences a year.
